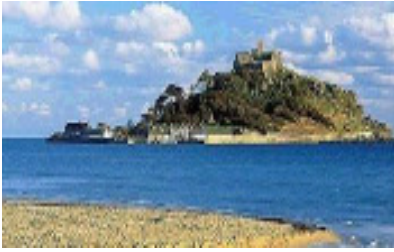

Cornwall

Beautiful Cornwall is in the extreme southwestern part of England. Cornwall is a peninsula encircled by coastline that abounds

with rugged cliffs, hidden bays, fishing villages, sandy beaches & sheltered coves where pirates & smuggling were once common. The Cornish people have a Celtic-Iberian origin which still lives on in superstition, folklore & fairy tales. Arthur is one of the main legends of this area.

Tentative Itinerary

Day 1 AM Arrive at Birmingham airport. Travel toward Tintagel, overnight on the way.

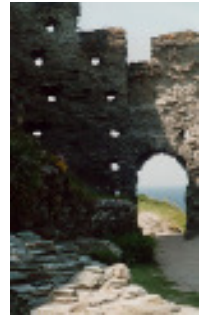
Day 2 & 3- Travel to Tintagel, on a wild stretch of the Atlantic coast, is the legendary birthplace of King Arthur. The 13th-century ruins of Tintagel castle stand on the cliffs above the sea. Optional visit to **Merlin's Cave**. Also visit to **Boscawen** and the Witchcraft Museum for those interested. Travel Day 4, down further into Cornwall for overnight next 4 nights.



Days 4, 5, 6, 7 - While in the Penwith area of Cornwall (furthest SW region of Cornwall including Lands End) we will visit **St. Ives**, the lovely seaside fishing village, famous for its sandy beaches and art colony. It is a village of narrow streets & quaint cottages with wonderful potters, weavers, artists & other craftspeople. We also will visit **St. Michael's**

Mount - Mysterious mount that rises 250 feet from the sea - topped by a partially medieval, partially 17th-century castle - only reached by a causeway at low tide. This area is filled with **Ancient Sites** dating back at least 5000 years - hundreds of quartz-studded granite standing stones, sacred wells, stone circles, chambered barrows & underground 'fogous' were erected during the following 3000 year period. **We will visit Merry Maidens Stone Circle, Boscawen-Un Stone Circle, Men An Tol, Lanyon Quoit, Holy Wells at Sancreed & Madron. Also evening visit for the sunset at Lands End, lunch at the beautiful Lamorna Cove, time for swimming at some beautiful beaches.**

Day 8 - Tour ends - continue on your own or travel to Birmingham airport for flights home or to Scotland on Day 9 (cost for hotel on Day 8 is extra; flights extra) or continue on with me up to Scotland tour, driving (costs during this time extra)



Tour Conditions

I. Price of Tour: Send deposit of \$450 to hold place as soon as possible as trip will fill. **See Registration Form for Prices.** The \$650 deposit is the same whether by check or credit card. (These costs are based on the exchange rate of 1.00 - 1.60 dollars per 1 British Pound Sterling. If the dollar falls in value before the trip, the price may have to be adjusted slightly upward.

II. Included: Price includes 7 nights accommodations in England, Tintagel & Cornwall twin/triple rooms; in Bed & Breakfast or Hotel; all breakfasts, transportation from designated airport at beginning of trip by minibus or car (depends on size of group) (must coordinate arrival time with us), to designated airport at end of trip & throughout tour; admission to sites listed; all workshops. Single room extra cost.

III. Not Included: Cost does not include airfare to/from Britain; lunches & dinners; passport & items of personal nature.



IV. Travel Arrangements - Well Within is also a travel agency. I can help with flights for a small fee. Must arrive at designated airport by a certain time & leave designated airport by a certain time. Can always come a day early or stay a day later if that is a problem (stay

near airport). **Check with me about your flights** if you want to book your own BEFORE you make final payment on those flights.

V. Deposit & Payments: \$650 deposit secures space. 1/2 of balance of payment due by **90 Days before Tour**. Remaining 1/2 of balance (full payment) due by **60 Days before Tour**. Total \$150 late payment fee added if payments not made by due dates (\$75 for each payment not met).

VI. Cancellations & Refunds: Refunds minus \$300 fee will be made if cancellation is postmarked by 150 days prior to departure. If cancellation postmarked between 90 - 149 days prior to departure, \$450 is non-refundable. If cancellation postmarked between 60-90 days prior to departure \$900 is non-refundable. If cancellation postmarked between 30-59 days prior to departure, \$1150 is non-refundable. If cancellation postmarked between 15-29 days before departure \$1300 is non-refundable; and under fifteen days from departure there is no refund.



We strongly recommend travel insurance, which enables you to recover all deposits if you need to cancel the trip due to illness or death. Please contact us if you want details on this insurance. No partial refunds will be given under any circumstances for unused hotel rooms, meals, or sightseeing trips.

Flights & Travel Arrangements

Well Within is a travel agency & all flights and travel arrangements can be made with us for a small fee.

A. The England tour is based on the exchange rate of 1.00 - 1.60 Dollars per Pound. If the dollar falls in value before the trip, the price may have to be adjusted slightly upward.
